



INAUGURAL INTER-CONDOMINIUM DOUBLES LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIPS 2017

1.1 ORGANISATION

- a. The tournament, shall be called the Inter-Condominium Doubles League Championships 2017.
- b. The tournament is jointly organised by Sport Singapore and TAG Tennis Pte. Ltd.
- c. The tournament shall be conducted under the rules and by-laws of the International Tennis Federation (ITF) in conjunction with the rules of this tournament.
- d. Any team which violates the rules and regulations in this document can be defaulted at any stage of the tournament by the Referee.

1.2 RIGHTS OF THE TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE

- a. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry without assigning a reason.
- b. It reserves the right to alter the format of the tournament in anyway it deems necessary.

1.3 REGISTRATION OF PLAYERS

- a. Competition is open to all subject to the rules in relation to team composition.
- b. Each team is required to field the following: 1 pair of Men's Doubles (no age restriction), 1 pair of Mixed Doubles (no age restriction), and 1 pair of Dynamic Doubles (which can comprise (i) Mixed Doubles (no age restriction); (ii) Men's Doubles both aged 45 and above; or (iii) Ladies Doubles (no age restriction).
- c. Minimum of 6 Players are required to play each tie. Therefore, a minimum of 6 players (including at least 1 female player for the Mixed Doubles) is required. Teams are required to ensure they have sufficient team members to be fielded in accordance with their strategy for the Dynamic Doubles pairing.
- d. A maximum of 12 players may be registered.
- e. A maximum of 2 players whose NRIC / Work Pass do not show their residential address as part of the condominium shall be permitted.
- f. Names of players must be given in full according to what appears in their identity card, and a copy of their NRIC / Work Pass must be submitted with the registration form.
- g. Deadline for submission shall be **27 September 2017 Wednesday at 6 pm.**

1.4 FORMAT OF TOURNAMENT

- a. Group League format will be used. Finals will be played on 28 October 2017 Saturday and 29 October 2017 Sunday at the Farrer Park Tennis Centre.

- b. Each tie will comprise 1 pair of Men's Doubles, 1 pair of Mixed Doubles, and 1 pair of Dynamic Doubles. The winner of the tie shall be the team that wins at least 2 of the 3 matches.
- c. Each match shall be played with no-ad scoring to 2 sets of first to reach 6 games. If the match is locked at one set each, a first to reach 10 points (with a difference of 2 points) super tie-break shall be played to determine the winner of the match.
- d. All teams and players must be present at the competition venue and must be able to compete in all matches throughout the day.
- e. All teams will be divided into pools in which each team will play a round robin to produce order of ranking in their pool. It is mandatory that participating teams play all the matches. The format of play is subjected to changes depending on the number of teams participating in each category. Winning teams will progress to next stage or finals depending on the number of participating teams.
- f. Official match timings are on Saturdays from 2 pm to 7 pm and on Sundays from 8 am to 12 pm. Teams may mutually agree to change their timings subject to the condition that the result of the weekly tie must be submitted by 11 pm on Sunday to the tournament referee.
- g. Dispute of any nature regarding a match should be brought to the referee's attention immediately. Protests and appeals will not be entertained after a match is completed.

1.5 AMENDMENT TO REGISTRATION OF PLAYERS

- a. The last day for any changes to names must be submitted by the deadline given by the organiser.
- b. All requests must be in writing to the organiser through email. Amendment made through mailing must be confirmed with a telephone call to the organiser office to ensure that the mail has been received.

1.6 ELIGIBILITY

This tournament is open to everyone.

1.7 PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEE

- a. The entry fee per team is S\$125.00 nett.
- b. Payment shall be made by cheque or bank transfer to the organiser before **3 October 2017 Tuesday**.

1.8 WALK-OVERS

- a. A walkover will be awarded 15 minutes after a player fails to show up at the match court. The 15 minutes shall be taken from the time the match is scheduled. 3 calls starting from the scheduled time will be made for the players at approximately 5 minutes interval. If a match is scheduled but has been delayed due to unavailability of court, players are expected to wait for their matches to be called. If the match is called, a walkover shall be awarded if a player fails to show up after the third call. Each call will be made at approximately one-minute interval.
- b. Walkover given by any team will result in a loss for the team for that tie.

1.9 SUBMISSION OF TEAM LINE-UP

- a. Submission of team line-up must be done no later than 5 minutes from the time the match has been scheduled. Thereafter, 3 calls at approximately one-minute interval will be made to request the team

captain to submit the line-up. At the end of the third call, a walkover will be declared if the team line-up is not received.

- b. The team line-up should be written neatly and names must be spelt in FULL.
- c. After the submission of the team line-up, no changes will be allowed.
- d. No repetition of players is allowed for each tie.

1.10 INCLEMENT WEATHER

In the event of rain, team managers must reschedule the tie. All matches must be completed before 24 October Tuesday at 11 pm.

1.11 POSTPONEMENT OF MATCHES

- a. In the event of a postponement, no changes are allowed in the line-up once a match has started. However, if no match has started, the teams can submit a new line-up.
- b. In the event of a postponement, if all matches are played simultaneously, no changes are allowed in the line-up once the matches have started. However, if no match has started, the teams can submit a new line-up for the rescheduled matches.

1.12 OFFICIAL TENNIS BALLS

ITF approved competition tennis balls will be issued by the organiser.

1.13 COMPETITION PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to at least the top 4 teams.

1.14 LUCKY DRAW PRIZES

- a. Lucky draw participation is only open to all players of the competition. Each player is entitled to 1 lucky draw chance.
- b. Winners must be physically present to collect the prize, no proxy allowed.
- c. If any winner is disqualified from the lucky draw, the tournament committee at its sole discretion may decide whether a replacement winner should be selected.
- d. Terms and conditions for lucky draw prize applies.

1.15 DISCLAIMER

- a. Competitors play at their own risk on any of the courts; Sport Singapore and TAG Tennis Pte. Ltd. and or its directors, employees, delegates or assigns shall NOT be responsible for any injury or loss of life, or any other mishaps during the tournament.
- b. Similarly, the parties mentioned above are not responsible for any loss of valuables or other personal belongings.
- c. These rules and regulations are subject to changes by the organiser.
